## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6650' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 3000 gallons Western 15% Low Tension Acid and started acid in tubing at 3:50PM without opening packer. No formation break. Oil flush of 30 bbls. complete at 4:44PM, 4-12-48, with final pressure of 2100#. Swabbed oil flush and acid water back at 9:00PM and hole dry. Continued swabbing and in 9 hrs. to 6:00AM, 4-13-48, swabbed 20.70 bbls. fluid, 10% acid water. In 11 hrs. to 5:00PM swabbed 19.94 bbls. fluid, 13.5% acid water.
