DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6650' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallons Western 15% Low Tension Acid. Formation broke from 2200# to 1700# on tubing and built up to final pressure of 2275#. Oil flush of 26.6 bbls. complete at 12:33PM, 4-11-48. Swabbed oil load and acid water and hole dry at 7:00PM. Turned to tanks and in 12 hrs. to 7:00AM, 4-12-48, swabbed 26.22 bbls. of fluid, 12% water. Swabbed to 3:30PM and recovered 5.52 bbls. fluid, 7% water.
