DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6650' Drilled Out Depth. Loaded hole with 45 bbls. oil, opened packer and acidized with 8000 gallons Western 15% Low Tension Acid. Started acid in tubing at 9:30PM, 4-13-48 and both casing and tubing full at 10:05PM. Started casing flush and at 10:30PM rest of acid was in tubing and started tubing flush. Csg. 1650#, tbg. 2000#. At 10:57PM oil flush of 148 bbls. complete. Csg. 1975#, tbg. 2070#. Closed circulating head on packer to make tbg. flush 27 bbls. to be recovered. Swabbed back oil flush and acid water and in 3 hrs. to 7:00AM swabbed 28.92 bbls. fluid, 50% acid water. In 38 hrs. to 9:00PM, 4-15-48, swabbed 115.92 bbls. fluid, 20% water. Strong head of gas with each pull of the swab. Stopped swabbing 9:00PM, 4-15-48 and rig released at 10:00PM same date. Well not completed.
