DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7275' Plugged Back Depth. Opened packer and started acidizing with 500 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid at 12:05AM, 3-29-48. Balanced acid in hole and closed packer. Oil flush of 28 bbls. complete at 1:43AM with 12 bbls. acid in formation. Final pressure 3100#, maximum pressure 3200#. Started swabbing and in 6 hrs. to 9:00AM recovered oil flush and acid water. From 9:00AM to 12 noon recovered 2.07 bbls. fluid, 60% B&W. From 12 noon to 7:00PM there was no recovery. Stopped swabbing.
