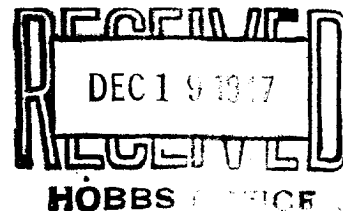

2880' Total Depth Line, Ran 27 jts 8 5/8" OD 28#, H-40, R-3, 8 RT Spang SS Casing New on bottom and 34 jts 8 5/8" OD 32#, R-1, 8 V 1/2" LW Sh in the middle and 27 jts 8 5/8" OD 28# H-40, R-3, 8 RT Spang SS Casing New on top and set casing at 2871' and cement with 1500 sacks common bulk cement, first 1000 sacks mixed 3% Howcogel and 50 Sacks Incor and plug pumped to 2785' at 11PM, December 17, 1947, and with a final pressure of 1100#.
