## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6680' Total Depth, Lime Acidized with 500 gals. Western mud acid. Staeted spotting acid in hole @ 4:40 P.M. Acid washed over formation 4 times, during 3rd. wash over closed well in & broke formation down w/2 bbls. acid w/2150# pressure. After 4th wash over reversed acid out of tubing, pressure while washing 500# to 600#, Reversed completed @ 6:10 P.M. Flowed well to pits, estimated 50 bbls. Oil, acid & water. Flushed with 39 $\frac{1}{2}$  bbls. oil, turned to tanks and started test.
