Cemented with 600 sacks Lone Star Bulk Cement and plug stopped at 6569' @ 12:40 P.M. 1-13-49. Max Pump Pressure 1600#. Set 8 Baker Centralizers at 6425'-6455'-6485'-6515'-6545'-6575'-6605'-6635'
