Gulf Oil requests your administrative approval for a 120 acre non-standard proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool, covering the S/2 SW/4 and the NW/4 SW/4, Section 20, 21-S, 37-E, to be dedicated to our C. L. Hardy No. 5 well, located 1980' FSL & 660' FWL of said Section.

In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

1. Subject well was reclassified, effective January 1, 1972 as a gas well in the Blinebry Gas Pool, due to Gas-Oil ratio in excess of 32,000/1, necessitating this non-standard unit.
2. There are no other wells producing from the Blinebry zone in this quarter section.
3. The attached plat show the proposed 120 acre non-standard unit outlined in red.
4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a governmental quarter section.
5. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application.

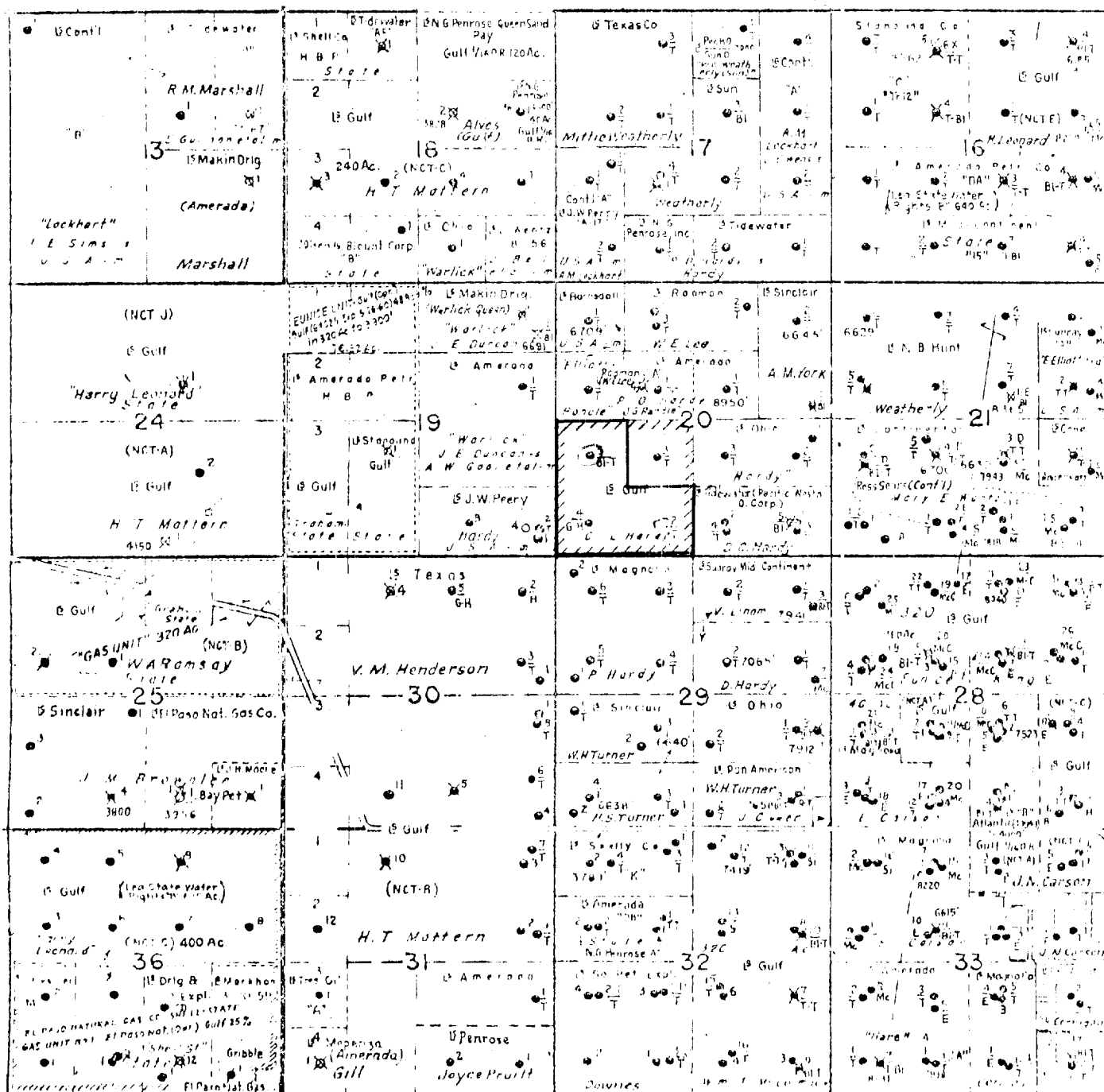
