Dear Mr. Porter:

Under Oil Conservation Commission Administrative Order No. DC-748, effective April 16, 1959, J. R. Cone was authorized to dually complete his Anderson Well No. 2 as a Wantz Abo Oil - Blinebry Gas dual. The Anderson No. 2 is located in Unit I of Section 21, T-21-S, R-37-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

On May 26, 1959, Anderson No. 2 was recompleted from the Hare to the Wantz Abo Pool. Dual completion was not attempted at the time in order to obtain first production history on the Abo. Subsequently, the Abo has practically ceased to produce and it now is planned to attempt recompletion in the Blinebry Oil Pool.

Accordingly, we request that Order No. DC-748 be cancelled inasmuch as we do not now plan to execute the originally proposed dual.
