FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well presently producing from sands of the Simpson through casing perforations 7697 to 7868 feet. The daily capacity is 45 barrels of oil plus 24 barrels of water with a gas-oil ratio of 3840.

We propose to jet perforate additional Simpson sands in the intervals 7945 to 7955 feet and 8016 to 8040 feet in an effort to stimulate oil production. It is anticipated that the lowermost of these sands will be treated with 1500 gallons of acid and possibly with 1500 gallons of Hydrafrac.
