T. D. 8250. Top First McKee sand 7680'. Top Ellenburger Dolomite 8215'.
Ran 8247' 5 1/2" 20# Casing set at 8247 with Halliburton two-stage tool at 7512'.
Pumped in 245 sacks which circulated out due to failure of two-stage tool.
Pumped in 500 sacks cement. Ran temperature survey which showed return to
4670'. Perforated casing at 7680 with 3 shots, set Baker "K" cement retainer
at 8221, established circulation and cemented with 150 sacks. Will let set
48 hours, and test casing with 1000# pressure for shut-off.
