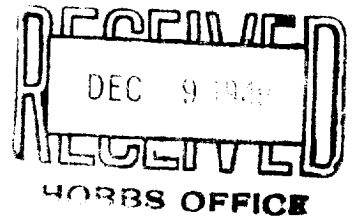

Subject well was drilled to 8230' and on 11-29-49 set 7' 00" casing at 8230' and cemented with 100 sacks regular cement below staging tool set at 7984' and 900 sacks 5% Gel cement and 100 sacks West cement above staging tool using 6 centralizers and 2 Baker metal petal washers.

On 12-5-49 found 30 cement sacks in casing. On 12-5-49 set 7' 00" casing at 8230' and cemented with 100 sacks regular cement below staging tool set at 7984' and 900 sacks 5% Gel cement and 100 sacks West cement above staging tool using 6 centralizers and 2 Baker metal petal washers.
