## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Form C-102, dated 8-9-48, reporting 7" casing set in the subject well, should be corrected to show depth set as 6699' instead of 6690'.

This casing was set on 8-8-48 with 1,025 sacks cement, using 44 centralizers and 254 scratchers.

On 8-11-48, this casing was tested with 1200# pressure for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. Pipe tested O.K.
