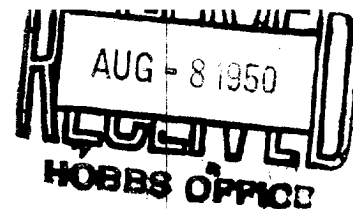

Set 5 1/2" CG casing at 7359 and cemented with 418 sacks cement. Total depth of hole 7360 in Shale and Sand. Plug down 8:30 A.M. 8-2-50. Top of cement by Temperature Survey 2300'.

After 48 hours CG casing will be tested with 1200' for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug.
