FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
 (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The subject well produced an average of 3 BO, 1 BW, w/219 MCFGPD by gas lift during October, 1962.

In order to restore the well to a commercial producing status, it is proposed to abandon the McKee formation and plugback and dual complete in the Glorieta and Blinberry formations. Plans call for setting a cast iron bridge plug at ~~5770~~ ^{5770-10'}; perforating Blinberry w/2 JSPP from 5770-72', 5807-10', 5825-27', 5837-40', 5869-71', 5883-86' and 5920-23'; treating these perforations w/500 gals acid and 20,000 gal sand fracture; perforating Glorieta formation w/2 JSPP from 5118-21', 5138-41', 5171-74' and 5192-95'; treating Glorieta perforations w/6000 gals acid; and installing dual completion equipment.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.
