## Gentlemens

It has recently been brought to the attention of this office that the gas production from your Mary E. Wantz Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SN/4 of Section 21, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico is being measured through a common meter with your Mary E. Wantz Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 21, T-21-S, R-37-E, Eumont Gas Pool.

This is to advise you that it will be necessary that separate meter installations be installed for these two leases. The problem is more apparent due to the fact that only a 120 acre allowable is assigned to the Well No. 2, whereas 160 acres is assigned to Well No. 1. As you can see, for proration purposes this method of measurement is not satisfactory. By carbon copy of this letter I am informing your transporter, Phillips Petroleum Company, that effective November 1, 1958 it will be necessary to measure the gas separately.
