Gentlemen:

Subject well conforms to the spacing requirements outlined in Order No. R-610 and is located in the NE corner of a standard Blinbry Gas Pool proration unit consisting of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 T21S R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The well is presently producing from the Drinkard formation through perforations from 6947' to 6982' with 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 6024'.

We respectfully request administrative approval to dually complete the subject well with production from the Blinbry formation to be produced through tubing casing annulus and production from the Drinkard formation to be produced through the tubing.

The enclosed diagrammatic sketch indicates the means whereby we will maintain separation of gas from the Blinbry formation from oil from the Drinkard formation.

On the enclosed plat we have outlined the proposed 160 acre Blinbry gas proration unit.

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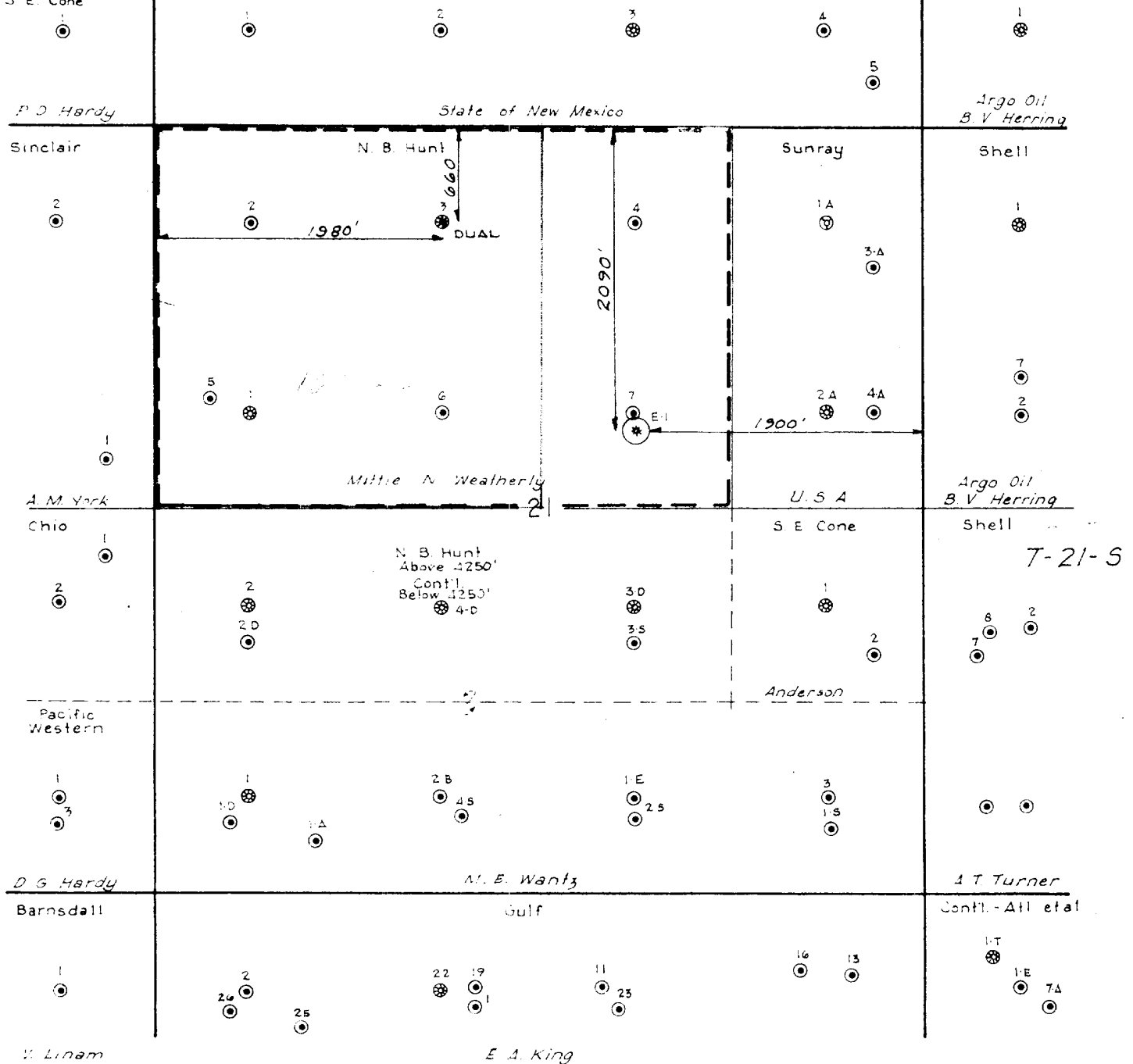
