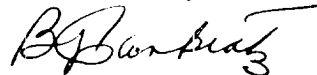
Gulf Oil Corporation requests your administrative approval for a 120 acre non-standard proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the NE/4 NE/4 and the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 22, 21-S, 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated simultaneously to our Eubank No. 2, located 660' FN & EL and Eubank No. 4, located 660' FEL and 1980' FNL, both in Section 22, 21-S, 37-E.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. Eubank No. 4 is a Blinebry Gas well with an 80 acre non-standard proration unit (NSP-681) comprising the S/2 of the NE/4, Section 22, 21-S, 37-E.
2. Recent test of Eubank No. 2 reveals the well will be reclassified from a Blinebry Oil to Blinebry Gas due to gas-oil ratio in excess of 50,000/1.
3. Rule 26 (e) of the Blinebry Gas Field Rules permit two producing gas well within a single proration unit with the operator having the option to determine the proportion of the assigned allowable to be produced by any well.
4. There are no other wells producing from the Blinebry formation in this 120 acre non-standard proration unit.
5. The attached plat shows the proposed 120 acre unit outlined in red.
6. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application.

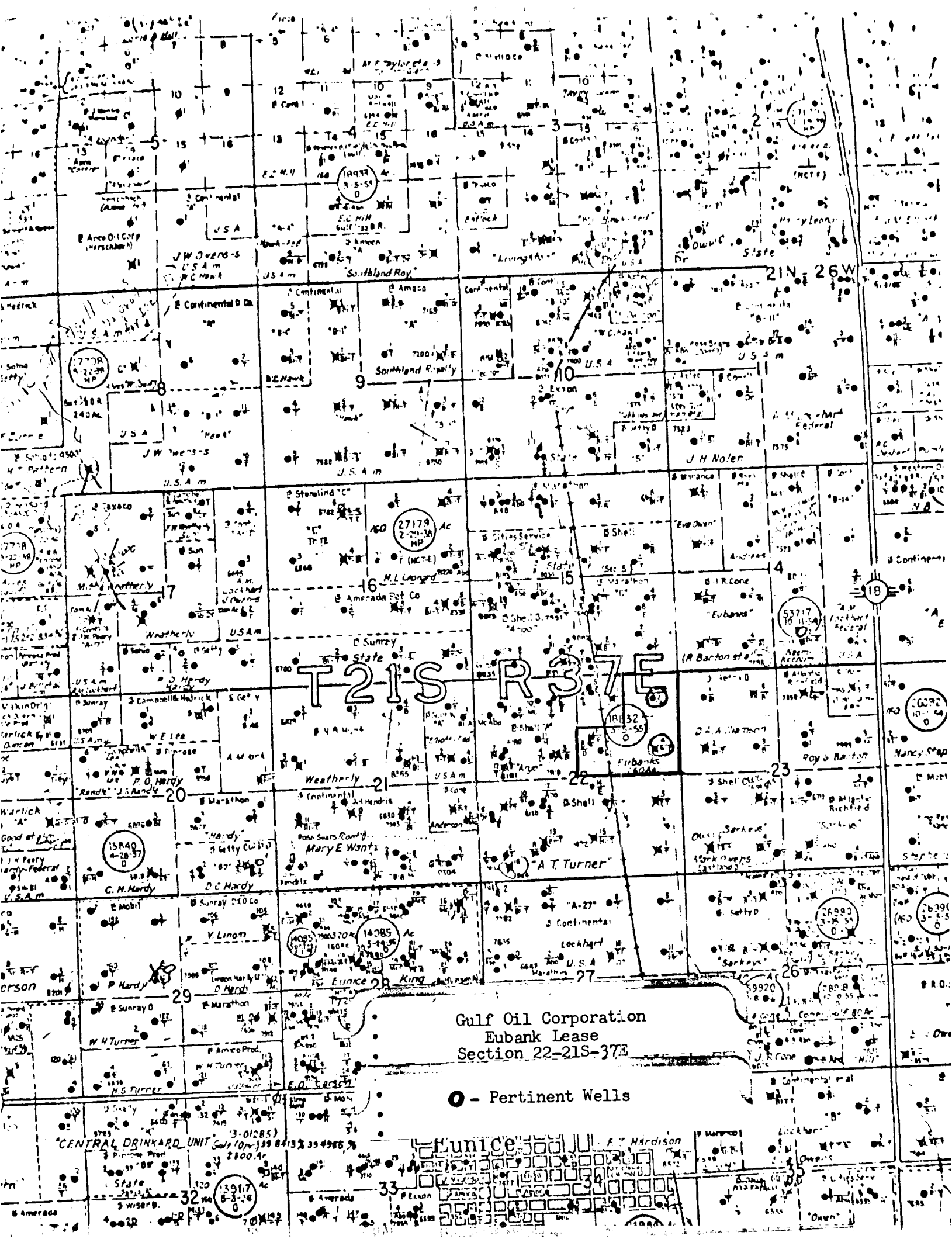
