Gentlemen:

Effective January 1, 1964 your Eubank No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 22, T-21-S, R-37-E and Hardy No. 5 located in Unit L of Section 20, T-21-S, R-37-E, Blinebry Gas Pool, are reclassified as oil wells. This reclassification is necessitated by your recently submitted gas-liquid ratio tests, which indicate the wells to be producing liquids of less than 51 gravity with a ratio of less than 32,000 cubic feet per barrel.

Please submit corrected Forms C-128 showing 40 acre dedication prior to January 1, 1964 in order that allowables may be assigned in the Oil Proration Schedule.

JOINT CONSERVATION COMMISSION

1. The purpose of this agreement is to provide for the joint management and conservation of the natural resources of the State of New Mexico and the State of Texas. The Commission shall be composed of representatives from both states, who shall meet regularly to discuss and coordinate conservation efforts. The Commission shall have the authority to make recommendations to the respective state legislatures regarding the management of natural resources. The Commission shall be responsible for the development and implementation of a comprehensive conservation plan for the State of New Mexico and the State of Texas. The Commission shall have the authority to request the necessary funding from the respective state legislatures.
