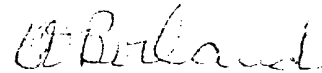
Gulf Oil Corporation requests your administrative approval for an unorthodox location on a 160 acre standard gas proration unit in the Tubbs Gas Pool for our Eubank No. 8, 1750' FNL and 2310' FEL of Section 22-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. Additionally, approval is requested to simultaneously dedicate Well No. 8 and Well No. 1 (located 660' FNL and 1780' FEL of Section 22-21S-37E) to the same 160 acre standard proration unit.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. This application is in the interest of conservation and prevention of waste.
2. Well No. 8 is located on the same 160 acre proration unit as Eubank No. 1; however, Well No. 1 is incapable of producing top allowable production.
3. The recompletion of Well No. 8 in the Tubbs Gas Pool represents a reasonable development in this pool.
4. The attached plat shows the proposed unorthodox location on the 160 acre standard proration unit and wells outlined.
5. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail.
