## Gentlemen:

Shell Oil Company hereby makes application for Administrative Approval to dually complete our Sarkeys Nos. 1, 2, and 3, all located in Section 23, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Separate applications are attached for each proposed dual completion.

Serkeys No. 1 is presently a Drinkard Cil-Tubb Gas dual. We propose to abandon the Drinkard zone and dual the existing Tubb Gas with Blinebry Cil. As illustrated on the attached schematic diagram, Tubb Gas (lower zone) will be produced through the annulus, and Blinebry Cil will be produced through the tubing by means of a crossover assembly.

Sarkeys No. 2 is presently a Drinkard Oil-Blinebry Gas dual. We propose to abandon the Blinebry Gas zone and dual the existing Drinkard Oil with Blinebry Oil. Each zone will be produced through separate tubing strings.

Sarkeys No. 3, presently a Drinkard single, will be recompleted as a Drinkard Oil-Blinebry Oil dual. Each zone will be produced through separate tubing strings.

All operators listed in Item 5 of the attached applications were furnished copies of each application, and have been asked to sign waivers consenting to the above dual completions. When the waivers are returned to us, we will immediately forward them to the Commission. Please contact this office if additional information is desired.
