
Dear Sir:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests administrative approval to dual complete its Roy Barton Well No. 2 as a dual Blinebry Oil-Drinkard, oil-oil dual. The well is located in Unit B, Section 23, T21S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The well is presently a Blinebry Gas-Wantz Abo Oil dual. It is proposed to squeeze the Blinebry Gas Zone and plug back from the Wantz Abo Zone in order to recomplete in such a manner that the Drinkard Oil and Blinebry Oil zones can be produced thru parallel strings of 2" OD tubing. Upon approval of this proposal the proper forms will be filed to cancel Blinebry Gas allowable and Wantz Abo Oil allowable.

Enclosed you will find the appropriate Commission application form, plat of the area, and diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual installation.
