DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Edna Water Williamson #2 was recently re-completed as a dual oil/gas (brinkeri/tubo) well. Tubo section open was 6115-6225'. After an oil current of 3000 gals. 15% regular acid through perforations 6115-6225', the well produced 1000 MCFD (from 1" pipe in 3" surface well tester).

In 6-19-51, in an effort to insure a production from the tubo, an additional 30' was opened by perforating this zone from 6037-71' and from 6115-98' with a bullets gun foam. After an acid treatment of 6000 gals. 15% regular acid and 200 gals. galy coal through perforations 6115-6225', 6037-71' and 6037-98', the well produced 1000 MCFD (from 2" pipe in 3" surface well tester).

No open flow potential test has been taken to date.
