Lane-Wells set Baker plug in casing at 5680' and dumped one sack cement on top of plug. Dowell, Inc., tested plug with 2,000# pressure. Lane-Wells perforated Blinberry Zone with 4 shots per foot from 5,554' to 5,574' and from 5,586' to 5,612'. Dowell acidized perforated zone with 3,000 gallons. Well was swabbed and kicked-off. Blew acid and water load to pits.

This well was shot with 70 Lane-Wells open-hole charges (2 per foot) at 6,509-26, 6,547-54 and 6,566-77. Tubing was swabbed dry. No oil or gas. We washed open hole from 6,456-6,600 with 500 gallons mud thru tubing and circulated out; this was followed by 1,000 gallons of acid. Formation would not take acid after holding 3,200# pressure on formation for 2 hours and 40 minutes. No results.
