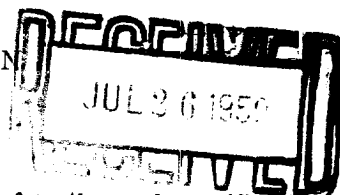

8 5/8" casing (new) was set and cemented with 500 sacks cement at 2848 feet. The Plug was pumped down at 10:45 AM 7/18/50. It is planned to run a temperature survey to locate the approximate top of the cement. After being allowed to set for 48 hours it is planned to test casing under pressure. If a successful test is obtained it is planned to drill plugs, test again under pressure and resume drilling with 7 7/8" hole.

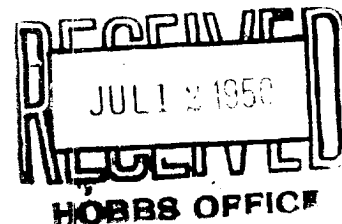

Ran 8 joints (321.17 feet) of 13 3/8" Spiralweld new casing plus landing joint and cemented at 333 feet with 200 sac cement. Used two plugs. Cement circulated into cellar. Top collar set 3 feet below ground level. Now waiting on cement.

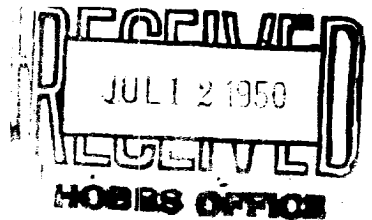

It is planned to keep the pressure on the surface casing for 12 hours after cementing, then to nipple up, set blowout preventers and, at the end of 48 hours after the plug was pumped down (plug down at 2:05 PM & cement circulated at 2:05 P.M. 7/10/50) to test under pressure. If a successful test is obtained, plugs will be drilled, casing tested again and drilling resumed with 11" hole.

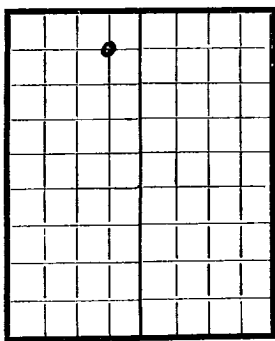
