DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 28, 1949, at 2:45 a.m. 36 hours had elapsed since running 304' of 13-3/8" casing set at 318' and cemented with 400 sacks to be used as surface string. Cement was circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 500 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement plug. Pressure drop did not occur on either test. Drilling was resumed.
