DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The 8-5/8" casing was perforated from 4340 to 4375' with 4 shaped charges per foot and the newly-perforated interval was acidized with 5,000 gallons of 15% acid.

Producing from all three perforated intervals (4340-75', 4404-40', 4452-70'), the well made 20 barrels of oil and 34 barrels of water in 24 hours on a representative test ending March 21, 1951.
