**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

In an effort to stimulate production, we propose to selectively acidize the perforated interval, 4404-4440', with 4,000 gallons 15% regular acid.

The pay opposite these perforations has not been tested separately.

Production from both perforated intervals, 4404-440', and 4452-70', has averaged approximately 17 barrels oil per day prior to this treatment.
