FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Reference is made to telephone conversation between Yarbrough and Courtright on April 8, 1950, in which verbal approval was given for testing pipe and water shut-off.

On April 9, 1950 at 1:30 A. M., 36 hours will have elapsed since cementing 13-3/8" casing at 330' with 400 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to the surface. Pipe and water shut-off will be tested before and after drilling shoe with 750# during 30 minutes.

In the event a satisfactory shut-off is not obtained, adequate remedial measures will be taken. If tests are satisfactory, drilling will be resumed.
