## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 13, 1950, after cement plug had set from 4400' to 4500', the well was acidized from 4298' to 4400' with 3,000 gallons acid. After pulling tubing and packer, well was tested with bailer. Test on October 17, 1950 showed well making 4 gallons of water and 1/2 gallon of oil every 2 hours during 18-hour period.

Drilling operations have been resumed.
