DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 20, 1950 at 1:00 A. M., 41 hours had elapsed since cementing the 10-3/4" O.D. surface casing at 329' with 200 sacks cement. Cement circulated to the surface. Pipe and water shut-off were tested before and after drilling cement plug by applying 500 psi for 30 minutes with no noticeable drop in pressure. Tests were considered satisfactory and drilling has been resumed.
