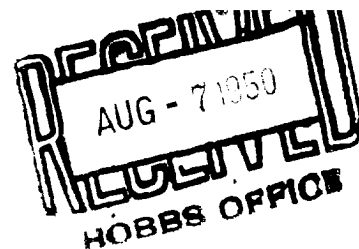

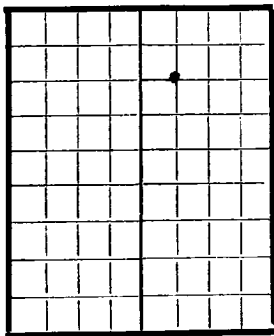

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary from surface to approx. 4500' unless commercial quantities of oil and/or gas are encountered at a lesser depth.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 35 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: On file with the Commission.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:
