## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well spudded February 15, 1937, and hole drilled to 230 feet. 230 feet of 10-3/4" 40 lb. lap-Weld pipe was run. Heavy mud was circulated ahead cementing and 155 sacks of cement were run. Cement returns to the surface. Additional sacks of cement were used to floor the cellar. Cement stood 30 hours, plug was drilled and hole baled dry for shut-off test and found to be satisfactory. Drilling continued.
