NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "C"

Well No. 2 in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16, T. 21, R. 36

N. M. P. M., Bunice Oil Field Lea County,

on 9-13 19 35, 9 in. 38 lb. casing was { cemented } in Anhydrite

formation at a depth of 1725 feet on 9-10 19 35

770 sacks of Common cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of \_\_\_\_\_ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Additional information: A pressure of 1200 pounds will be applied to the casing and the drop in pressure noted over a period of 30 minutes. The plug will then be drilled and the above operation repeated.
