DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "C" Well No. 3 was dually completed as a dual oil-gas well. A gamma ray and neutron log was run. Seven inch casing was tested and no leaks were found. Ran Baker Model D production packer with seal nipple latching plug set at 3695'. Picked up 2" tubing, went in hole, set anchor landed at 3832', tested packer at 850# o.k. Perforated Seven Rivers from 3130' to 3250' with 240 shots. Ran tubing, swabbed gas in and cleaned up. Packer leakage test was made and rig released. Tested Seven Rivers Gas, 72 hr. SI pressure 1100#, stabilized flow on 17/64" choke, FCP 625#, 1230 MCF/day rate. Oil will be produced through tubing and gas through casing-tubing annulus.
