DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill this well with rotary tools at the above location to an estimated TD of 6000'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with U.S.G.S. standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 10 3/4" OD set at 250' with 250 sacks, cement to circulate; 7 5/8" OD set at 3150' with 1100 sacks, cement to return to 1250'; 5 1/2" OD set at 6000' with 500 sacks, cement to return to 3050'; actual amount of cement used to set intermediate and production casing to be determined by caliper survey.

Permission is requested to produce this well upon completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

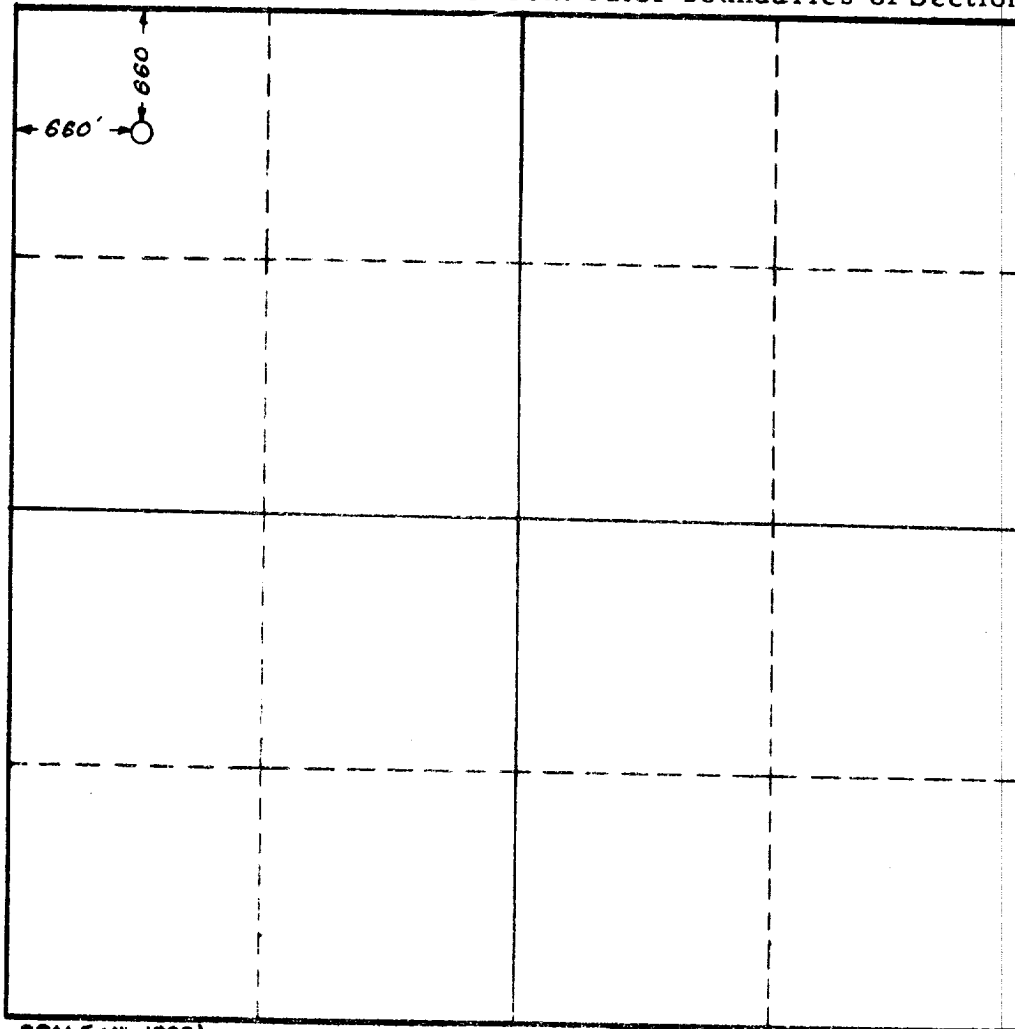
