DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 9:00 P.M. March 29, 1939, 72 hours had elapsed, at which time we tested the new 7" OD casing that was set at 3524' and cemented with 300 sacks cement.

Test was conducted in the following manner: Pressure was built to 1000#, valves were closed and pressure held thirty minutes, test was OK. Plug was drilled and 1000# pressure again applied, valves were closed, pressure was held for thirty minutes, Test OK.
