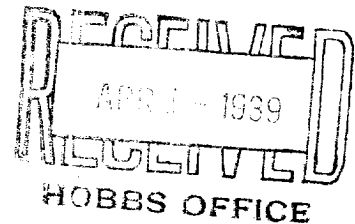

At 9:00 P.M. March 29, 1939, 72 hours will have elapsed, at which time we desire to test new 7" OD casing set at 3524' with 300 sack of cement.

We plan to conduct the test in the following manner: Build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold for thirty minutes. If test is OK we will drill plug, again apply 1000# pressure, close the valves and hold for thirty minutes.
