An attempt will be made to recover the uncemented portion of the 9-5/8" and 7" casing strings, and cement plugs placed as follows in order to isolate the salt section and all fluid bearing zones.

20 sx. cement plug	3513-3413'
20 sx. cement plug in 7" csg. stub	1400-1500'
20 sx. cement plug	At Surface

A heavy mud laden fluid will be mixed and placed between all cement plugs. The location will be cleared and a 4" marker will be erected to extend 5 feet above the ground level in compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
