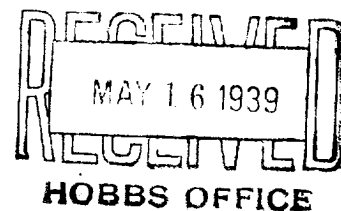
## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

At this time we plan to test this water shut-off by drilling plug, bailing hole dry, letting stand two hours.

If test is okay, drilling will be resumed.
