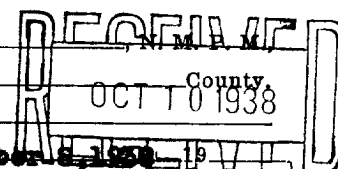

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 12:30 P.M. 48 hours had elapsed since setting the 13" OD used casing landed at 273' and cemented with 200 sax. At this time test was run and drilling resumed. Test was conducted in the following manner:

Pressure was built up to 1000# and held for thirty minutes. Plug was then drilled and well was allowed to stand for two hours. Bailing test was then run and hole was dry/ Drilling was then started again.
