Work Done: Pulled csg. 5600-5700. Acidized perforations w/10,000 gals. Acidized 5720-5840 w/10,000 gals. and 6,000%. Acidized 5600-5700 w/100 gals. and sandstone w/10,000 gals. and 6,000%. Ran csg. w/packer and dual equipment.

After completion of above work, 5600-5700 thru perf. 5600-5700, 5720-5840. IP flow 1.01 bbls. 73.7 (prev. 51.5) rate per hr. on 10 hr. test thru 3/4" choke. Daily rate 120 bbls. 1750 MCFD. Calculated flow potential 1750 MCFD. Shut in pressure 1835 psig. Deliverability at 200 psig 1637 MCF. Deliverability at 600 psig 1637 MCF. Estimated daily allowable 200 bbls. 1750 MCF. El Paso Nat. Gas Co. Tested 7-13-55.
