FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was drilled to a total depth of 8182' in lime. It has been plugged back 8066'. It is perforated from 7800' to 7850' and open hole from 8030 to 8066'. The well is shut-in at the present time because it was uneconomical to produce. It is proposed to plug off the open hole and the three intervals (1) 7974-90; (2) 7910-38, 7887-7902, 7872-78; (3) 7742-92 be opened, sand-oil fractured and tested individually in that order. Difficulty in sand-oil fracturing of first zone would result in acid treatment of other zones. It is believed that the completion of this work will restore the well to economic producing status. It is estimated that the well will produce 80 barrels of oil per day after workover.
