DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 312' red bed. Ran 7-3/8" joints of 13-3/8" casing (295.68') set at 311.68' and cemented with 325 sacks. Plug was down 2-19-51. Cement circulated. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute period. Test was made prior to and after drilling plug.
