Total depth 6673', lime. Ran 166 joints (6612') of 5 1/2" OD J-55  
 15.5# casing, set at 6625' and cemented with 350 sacks. Plug down at 4:45 P.M.  
 May 17, 1948. Cement was allowed to set 30 hours, 1000# pressure was built  
 up, closed valves and allowed to stand 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
