Dear Sir,

E. G. Rodman et al, hereby petition the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval to dual complete their W. E. Lee et al, Well No. 4 as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool and as an oil well in the Penrose-Skelly Oil Pool, and to establish a 240 acre non-standard gas proration unit as provided in Order R-520, dated August 1, 1954, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. E. G. Rodman et al leases contain 240 acres. This 240 acres is described as follows:

NW/4 and W/2 of NE/4 of Section 20, T-21-S, R-37-E,
NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

This acreage is located in the Eumont Pool and the Penrose-Skelly Oil Pool.

2. Well No. 4 is located 1980 feet south of the north line and 1650 feet east of the west line of Section 20, T-21-S, R-37-E. Application to drill this well to the Penrose-Skelly Pool was made May 15, 1957; however this well has not yet been completed.
3. Notice of Intention to dual complete this well in the Eumont Gas Pool and Penrose-Skelly Oil Pool and to assign 240 acres to the well for gas allowable were sent by registered mail to Sinclair Oil and Gas Company, Ohio Oil Company, Gulf Oil Corporation, Amerada Petroleum Company, Makin Drilling Company, J. W. Peery, N. G. Penrose, Inc., and Tidewater Associated Oil Company. Return receipts are attached.
4. Well No. 4 was drilled to a total depth of 3815 feet with 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 3700 feet and cemented. Casing will be perforated from 3570 to 3590 feet opposite the Queen Sand for completion as a gas well. Penrose-Skelly oil production will be from open hole 3700 to 3815 feet. The above perforations are within the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool and the open hole is within the vertical limits of the Penrose-Skelly Oil Pool.
5. By appropriate conventional dual completion equipment, the gas from the Eumont Gas Pool can be produced through the casing-tubing annulus, and the oil from the Penrose-Skelly Oil Pool through the tubing. The separately produced zones will be in conformance with Oil Conservation Commission policies and specifications pertaining to dual completions in the State of New Mexico.

Mr. W. B. Macey et al, hereby petition the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval to drill complete their W. B. 1. W. B. Macey et al, hereby petition the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval to drill complete their W. B. Macey et al, Well No. 4 as a gas well in the amount gas pool and as an oil well in the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool, and to establish a 240 acre non-estimating gas provision unit as provided in Order A-520, dated August 1, 1954, and in support thereof states as follows:

W. B. Macey et al, hereby petition the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval to drill complete their W. B. Macey et al, Well No. 4 as a gas well in the amount gas pool and as an oil well in the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool, and to establish a 240 acre non-estimating gas provision unit as provided in Order A-520, dated August 1, 1954, and in support thereof states as follows:

This acreage is located in the amount gas pool and the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool.

2. Well No. 4 is located 1980 feet south of the north line and 1050 feet east of the west line of Section 20, T-21-S, R-37-E. Application to drill this well to the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool was made May 15, 1957; however this well has not yet been completed.

3. Notice of intention to drill complete this well in the amount gas pool and Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool and to assign 240 acres to the well for gas allowance were sent by registered mail to Sinclair Oil and Gas Company, Oil Company, Gulf Oil Corporation, Amstar Petroleum Company, M. J. Petroleum Company, L. J. Petroleum, K. J. Petroleum, and Tidewater Petroleum Oil Company. Return receipts are attached.

4. Well No. 4 was drilled to a total depth of 3815 feet with 5 1/2" casing set at 3700 feet and cemented. Casing will be perforated from 3200 to 3500 feet opposite the Green Sand formation as a gas well. Pennose-Skelly oil production will be from open hole 3700 to 3815 feet. The above perforations are within the vertical limits of the amount gas pool and the open hole is within the vertical limits of the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool.

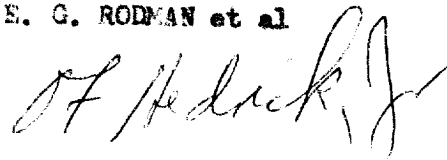
5. By appropriate conventional drill completion equipment, the gas from the amount gas pool can be produced through the casing-tubing annulus, and the oil from the Pennose-Skelly Oil Pool through the tubing. The separately produced gases will be in conformance with Oil Conservation Commission policies and specifications pertaining to dual completion in the State of New Mexico.

6. In order to produce this lease without incurring the cost of additional drilling and to protect all correlative rights, a non-standard gas proration unit of 240 acres is requested for the W. E. Lee et al No. 4 Well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The entire acreage consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections completely situated in Section 20, T-22-S, R-37-E, and the length does not exceed 5280 feet.
7. Gas wells are producing from the Queen Sand on adjacent sections, and it is reasonable to assume that the entire 240 acres is productive of gas and that Well No. 4 is so located as to recover the gas reserves underlying the 240 acres.
8. All surrounding leasehold operators of the proposed unit are being furnished a copy of this application by Registered Mail.
9. Properly completed Form C-102 and Form 128 in quintuplet are attached, as is diagrammatic sketch of proposed dual. Copies are also being furnished the operators receiving a copy of this petition.

E. G. Rodman et al, request that in the interest of conservation and to protect the correlative rights, the Commission grant administrative approval of this petition.

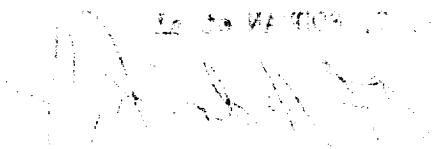

6. In order to produce this lease without incurring the cost of additional drilling and to protect all non-competitive rights, a non-competitive gas production unit of 100 acres is requested for the W. L. Lee et al. for 1 year in the amount of \$100. The entire acreage consists of 100 acres of gas and 100 acres of water. The unit is located in Section 20, T-10N, R-32E, and the length does not exceed 1000 feet.
7. Gas wells are proposed from the above land on adjacent sections, and it is requested that the unit be located so as to protect the gas and that well No. 1 is so located as to recover the gas reserves underlying the 100 acres.
8. All surrounding leasehold operators of the proposed unit are being furnished a copy of this application by Registered Mail.
9. Property completion form 100 and form 100 in duplicate are attached, a 1/2 horsepower check of proposed well. Copies are also being furnished the operators receiving a copy of this application.
10. Robert et al. request that the interest of conservation and in production the conservation rights, the Commission grant administrative approval of this application.

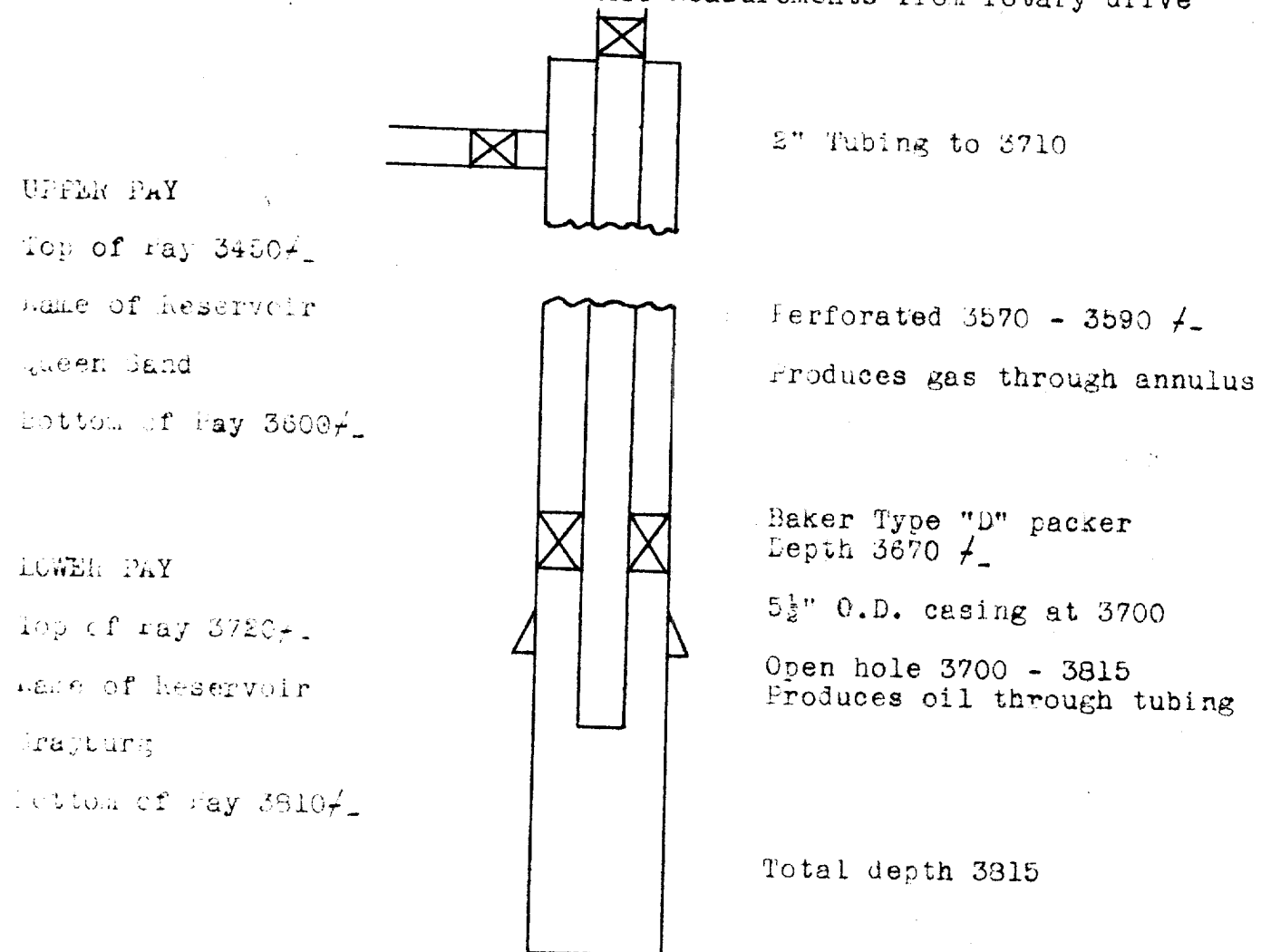

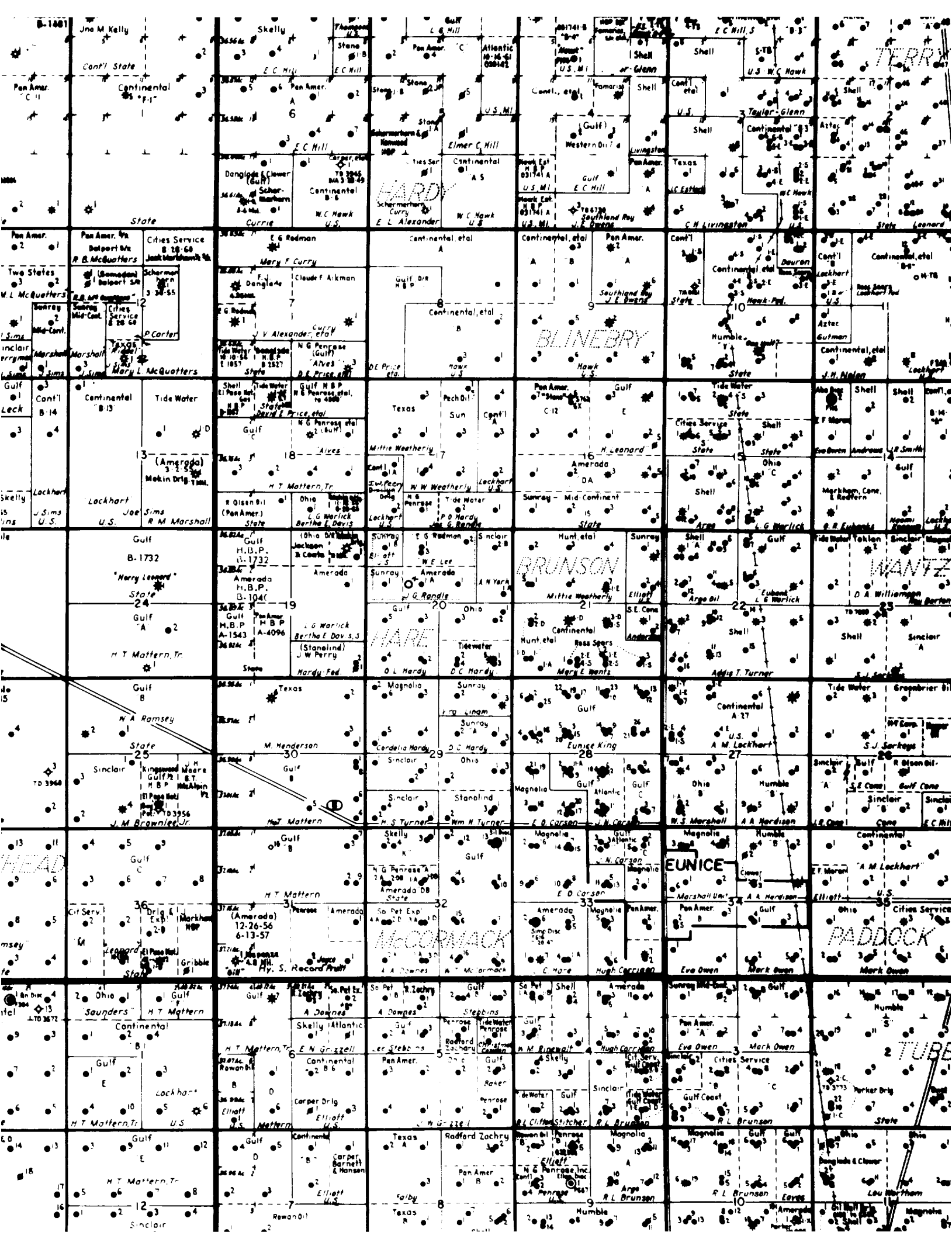
DUAL COMPLETION SKETCH - Proposed

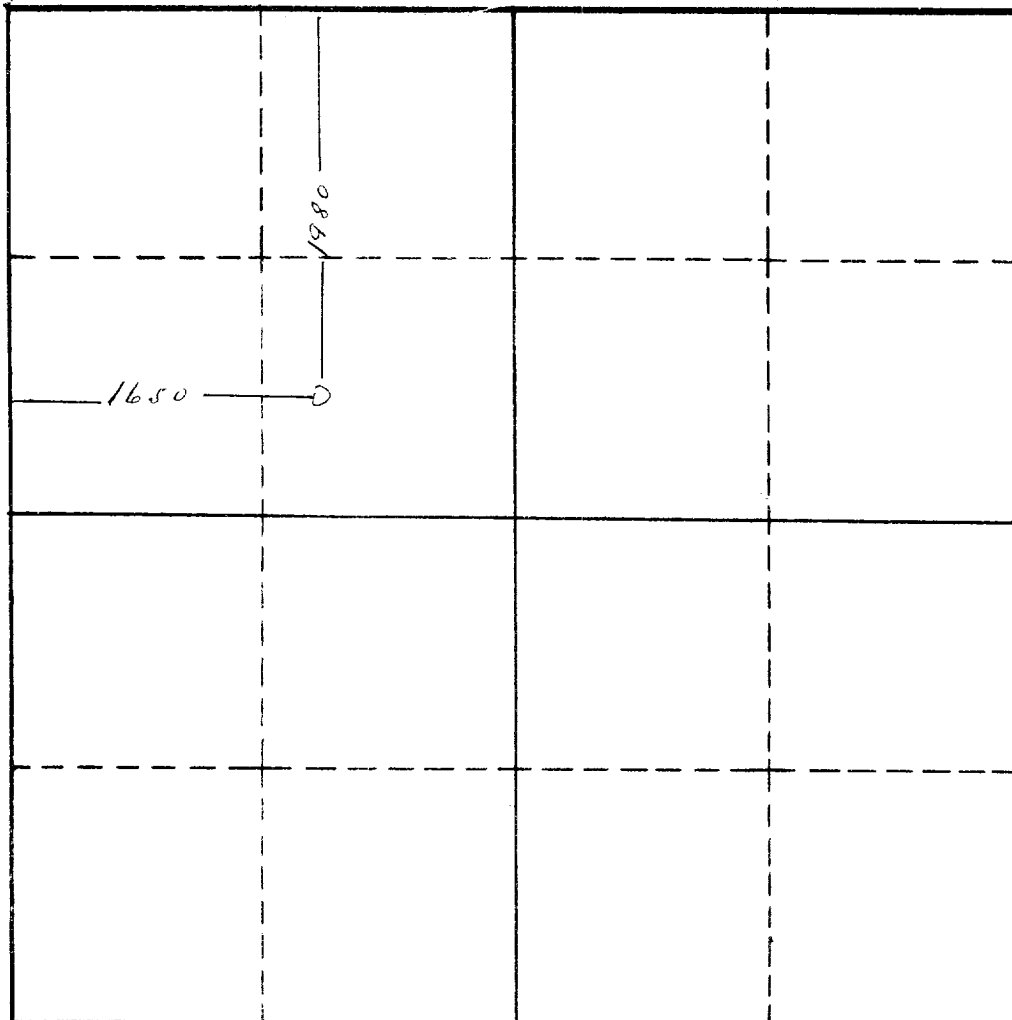
