

The Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit to be assigned subject well consists of the E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 20-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located 660 feet from the West, North, and East lines of the unit. The length or width of this unit does not exceed 2,640 feet and it is contained in a single governmental quarter section. The leasehold interest is common under the entire unit. Subject unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool.

Sinclair believes that the granting of this application is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.


Sinclair has notified all offset operators as defined in orders R-316 and R-586 of this application by copy thereof via registered mail. Said operators are listed on next page.
