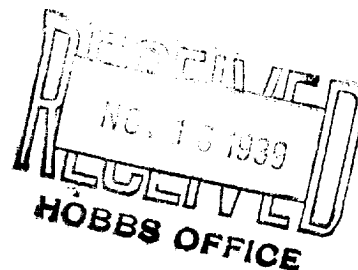

The Bureau of Plant Industry, United States Department of Agriculture, was organized on July 1, 1905, by the transfer of the plant industry functions of the United States Botanical Garden to the Department of Agriculture. It is the policy of the Department to maintain the Bureau as a permanent organization, and to provide for its continued development and expansion.

The Bureau of Plant Industry is organized into three main divisions: the Division of Plant Industry, the Division of Plant Quarantine, and the Division of Plant Pathology.

The Division of Plant Industry is responsible for the collection, cultivation, and distribution of plants and plant products.

The Division of Plant Quarantine is responsible for the inspection and quarantine of plants and plant products imported into the United States.

The Division of Plant Pathology is responsible for the study and control of plant diseases and insect pests.

The Bureau of Plant Industry is also responsible for the publication of reports and bulletins on plant industry.
