## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized open hole 6599' to 6628 feet with 2000 gallons 15% LST acid. Flowed approximately 500 barrels oil on 16/64-inch choke then died (oil and acid load 242 barrels) due to excessive separator pressure, separator pressure cut to 10 p.s.i. Well opened up and flowed for approximately 2 hours and died. After shut-in 16 hours, flowed 188 barrels oil cut 0.8% BS through 1/4" choke. C.P. 1200 p.s.i. T.P. 0 psi. Ending pressures: C.P. 1150 psi. T.P. 450 psi. G.O.R. 1102.
