Washed formation 6599 - 6628' with 500 gallons mud acid. Acidized open hole 6599 - 6628' with 1000 gallons 15% acid. Recovered lead oil in 4 hours. Then on Official Potential Test flowed 732.09 barrels oil, out 3% BS, no water through 1-inch choke in 24 hours. Gravity 38.4 degrees A.P.I. corrected. Gas oil ratio 918.
